## Catholic Theological College

As well as short courses, the Catholic Theological College offers formal qualifications in Religious Education through the 'Certificate in Christian Studies' and the 'Diploma in Christian Studies', both with a focus on Religious Education.

The study consists of papers in Theology, Scripture and Religious Education. At the diploma level, there is a choice of which particular courses are studied. This would be considered the minimum qualification that a specialist teacher of Religious Education would be working towards.
