The Archdiocese is seeking to appoint a Safeguarding Advisor. Working closely with, and providing advice to the Archbishop, and liaising with the archdiocesan and parish leadership teams, you will:

- take responsibility for the ongoing implementation and oversight of the safeguarding of children, young people and vulnerable adults across the Archdiocese;
- demonstrate significant experience in safeguarding and child protection;
- possess sound knowledge of New Zealand legal requirements concerning safeguarding;
- have a sound knowledge of Te Titiri o Waitangi: The Treaty of Waitangi and how these principles are brought to life through the mission of the Catholic Church in Aotearoa New Zealand;
- be a collaborative team player with excellent communication, facilitation and influencing skills;
- have a personal commitment to uphold the values and principles of safeguarding within the Catholic Church in New Zealand.

This is a challenging and demanding position requiring insight, professional judgement, engagement skills and a commitment to safeguarding. The appointee will have the chance to play a key role in assisting the Archbishop to implement the mission of the Archdiocese.
